Standard Condition(s):

LL065 The licensee will ensure that liquor is not removed from the licensed area.

LL066 No liquor shall at any time be sold or supplied to, or consumed by, any person under the age of 18 years.

No liquor shall at any time be sold or supplied to, or consumed by any person who LL067 is unduly intoxicated or disorderly.

Noise emanating from the premises to which this permit relates from entertainment LL071 or other activities and conduct by any person within the premises or while entering or leaving the premises shall not be such as to unduly disturb or inconvenience the owners or occupiers of neighbouring premises.

LL075 Liquor may only be sold and supplied between the hours specified in the permit and may only be consumed during those hours and for a period of 30 minutes grace after the cessation of the sale of liquor.

LL076 The grant and issue of this licence does not in any way relieve the licensee, or any other party, of an obligation to obtain any other relevant licence, permit, permission, consent or approval, whether from the Commonwealth or State Government, the local authority, the owner or occupier of the relevant premises, or any person or authority.

Liquor may only be sold or supplied to club members and guests of those members whilst in the member's company, and to members of reciprocal clubs and quests of those members whilst in the member's company. Guests must be signed in, in accordance with the requirements of the Liquor Act.

LL084 The sale of takeaway liquor is not permitted.
